- **TIE UP AREA** Upon arrival horse boxes shall be directed onto the Show field to be parked and horses are to be tied to their own box or lorry. Horses are not to be unloaded off the show field. The entrance for horse boxes is beside the main gate of the show field and it is for this reason that all horses and ponies **MUST** be on the grounds by **8.30am** and unless of an emergency you will not be able to leave the grounds until approximately **4pm** to enable the area to be cleared of the public at the main gate.
- **For safety reasons all ponies and horses are to be on the show ground by 8.30am to complete registration.**
- You must notify a steward before you leave the show ground.
- Riders may be asked to ride another horse or pony in the appropriate class.
- The organisers and land owners do not accept any liability for accident or damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- The organisers hold the right to amalgamate, alter or cancel any of the classes.
- Handlers of horses or ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years old and under must wear a correctly secured skull cap/riding hat which meets the current regulations.
- All competitors in the ridden classes must wear a correctly secured skull cap/riding hat that meets current regulations.
- No ill treatment of horses or ponies at any time, whether by misuse or excessive use of whip, bit, item of saddlery or in any other way what so ever will be permitted.
- A fall of horse/pony or rider in any class will result in disqualification; the rider must not remount in the ring.
- The rider/handler may not remove themselves or their horse/pony from the ring during judging without the judge's permission. The Class will end when the judge has dismissed the class.
- The decision of the judge is FINAL in every case.
- All competitors are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horses, non-compliance will result in a £50 fine.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse, cancel or transfer any entry/entries at their discretion.
- Entries received will not be refunded except on production of vet's certificate.
- Leaders of ponies in ridden classes must be 14 years old and over.
- Lead rein in riding classes must be attached to the nose band only.
